



The Worship Arts Ministry Team seeks to provide worship experiences where people connect with God through diverse, dynamic, creative worship style that appeal to all ages and spiritual temperaments.

- **Worship Arts—Preparation of the Sanctuary for all worship services, special events, and other spiritual services**
- **Altar Guild—Preparation of Communion for worship services; preparation of the baptistry for baptismal services; and upkeep of the Sacristy**
- **Worship Coordinator—Schedules worship participants including acolytes, readers, servers and others as needed**
- **Acolytes and Communion Celebrants—**
 - **Acolytes—bring the congregation into the worship space through the Processional and end the service through the Recessional by carrying the cross and candles; serve at the altar during Communion**
 - **Communion Celebrants—consecrate the elements of Communion; serve worshippers Communion and provide a prayer of encouragement**
- **Ushers and Greeters—welcome worshippers to the church; offer guidance as needed during worship services; collect the tithes and offerings; assist worshippers during Communion; remove trash and straighten chairs after services. It is necessary for ushers and greeters to arrive at church at least 15 minutes before scheduled worship times in order to**
